Provision of Food and Related Supplies 2024 NL Summer Games

Background

The 2024 Newfoundland and Labrador Summer Games will be held in Bay Roberts from August 10 – 17, 2024. Held every second year, alternating winter and summer, the Games is the largest multi-sport event staged for youth of our province to share in the spirit of athletic competition.

Competitions are broken up into two halves of the scheduled week. The first group of athletes, coaches and managers arrives on Saturday, August 10 and departs on Tuesday, August 13. The second group will arrive Wednesday, August 14 and depart Saturday, August 17. The total number of athletes, coaches and managers attending these games is estimated to be 1600 (800 per half).

The 2024 Games are managed by a local Host Committee and any funds generated because of these Games will go directly into the sport and leisure services for both the local youth and host community. The committee strives to create a legacy from these Games that will contribute to the overall health, well-being and enjoyment of all community members for many years to come.

<u>Description of Services Required</u>

The host committee is seeking the services of an experienced food distribution wholesale company to provide food products and supplies to the caterer for the 2024 Newfoundland and Labrador Summer Games.

The Athletes Village will consist of Ascension Collegiate on the Conception Bay Highway and Amalgamated Academy on Eric Dawe Dr in Bay Roberts. Our plan is to use cafeterias at both schools for breakfast service, while lunch and supper is to be centralized at

Amalgamated Academy. Classrooms at both schools will be utilized for an after-hour snack self-service area once the main cafeteria service has closed. "Food" as identified throughout this Request for Proposals will include all food and condiments used in the preparation of meals served to and made available for athletes and coaches during the Games. "Supplies" include plates, utensils, containers and napkins etc. used in the serving of food.

The food distributor will work with the catering company to provide the products required for the provision of meals to athletes and coaches in the Athlete's Villages as designated by the Host Committee, including containers for take-away meals.



Food Provider Contract

The successful bidder to this Request for Proposals is referred to as "the Vendor" and by submitting a bid, agrees to the following contract details:

Terms and Conditions

- The contract with the Vendor will be valid from Friday, August 9, 2024, until Monday, August 19, 2024, inclusive.
- The 2024 NL Summer Games Host Committee reserves the right to perform an evaluation of the service provided by the Vendor after the first half of the weeklong contract. Failure to meet the obligations may result in the termination of the food supplier contract.
- The 2024 NL Summer Games Host Committee does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid submitted.
- Responses must be open to acceptance for a period of 30 days.
- The quantity of each item or product listed in Appendix A may change due to changes in attendance and the menu.



Provision of Services

- Menu selections for the Games shall follow the nutritional guidelines contained in Canada's Food Guide as provided by the caterer.
- In conjunction with the Food Services Committee and the caterer, the Vendor will agree to coordinate delivery of ordering food and supplies.
- All food and food related supplies remaining after the Games will be the property of the Host Committee and are not to be removed by the Vendor.
- On site refrigerated storage "reefers" will be required at both cafeteria sites and will be included as part of the proposal.
- Emergency response for unforeseen shortages or special deliveries will be included as part of the proposal.
- Pricing for additional items including delivery should be clearly outlined in the price listing. Any volume discounts offered should be clearly outlined in the price listing provided.
- Respondents should also include a description of how incomplete or late orders are addressed as well as how orders are completed. Include descriptions of assurances for delivery of on-time and complete orders, as well as the process by which orders are placed and any relevant timelines for the placing of orders. Additional consideration may be made for providers able to provide reasonable assurances that all orders will be delivered complete and on time.



Exclusivity of Supplier

The food services agreement will provide for exclusive rights to provide all required food (excluding water), and other food service supplies (containers, plates, napkins, etc.) required by the caterer for the provision of meals for athletes, coaches, and Games officials for the 2024 NL Summer Games.

The exclusivity agreement does not include provision of food to any Host Committee or VIP sponsored reception or any function leading up to and during the Games, including Hospitality Suites.

Evaluation Criteria

All submissions will be evaluated by the Host Committee in consultation with the Food Services Committee based on the criteria listed below. Each criterion is assigned a weighted value to represent the importance of quality food service to the Games participants. Responses should address all criteria. The response that best satisfies the RFP will score the highest.

Responders must comply with all terms and conditions set out in this document. Vendors interested in submitting a proposal for the provision of food and supplies are asked to inform the Games office of their intention to bid by **Friday**, **February 9**, **2024**.

Final proposals must be received by the Games office **no later than 4:00 PM on Thursday, February 23, 2024**. <u>No late bids will be reviewed</u>.

- 1. Total Cost of Requested Food and Supplies 30 Points
 - 1.1. Detailed costs of food and supplies, including all applicable taxes, are to be submitted.



2. Delivery and Storage – 40 Points

- 2.1. Up to three deliveries per day will be included as part of the proposal.
- 2.2. On site refrigerated storage "reefers" will be required at both cafeteria sites and will be included as part of the proposal.
- 2.3. Emergency response for unforeseen shortages or special deliveries will be included as part of the proposal.
- 2.4. The Vendor shall demonstrate appropriate training certificates, licenses, permits and registration to operate a business within Canada and Newfoundland and Labrador
- 2.5. Additional consideration may be made for providers able to provide reasonable assurances that all orders will be delivered complete and on time.

3. Management and Organization – 30 Points

- 3.1. The Vendor's reputation and service history in the community.
- 3.2. The Vendor's ability to provide the food products and supplies required efficiently, on time and within budget.
- 3.3. The Vendor's understanding of the importance of providing the highest quality level of service to our athletes and coaches to make the games experience memorable for all the right reasons.
- 3.4. The Vendor's ability to be flexible and provide suitable replacements or substitutes of equal or higher quality in case of inventory supply issues.



Interested parties are asked to submit a **Proposal for Provision of Food and Related Supplies for the 2024 NL Summer Games**. The proposal should include, but is not limited to, a description of the following:

- Corporate Management and relevant previous experience in providing similar products and services.
- Ability to supply all products requested.
- Ability to perform requested services.
- Detailed product list and pricing including volume discounts.
- Complete and accurate response providing all information requested for evaluation.

The 2024 NL Summer Games Host Committee is not bound to accept the lowest or any proposal. Proposals, in sealed envelopes clearly marked, "Proposal for Provision of Food and Related Supplies for the 2024 NL Summer Games" must be received at the Games Office no later than 4:00 PM on Thursday, February 16, 2024.

No late bids will be reviewed.

Proposals will be accepted either in person, by email or by mail.
